On November 11, the United States along with many nations around the world will mark the 100th anniversary of the end of World War I. Dr. Julian Haber in his book “The Yanks Are Coming, Over There, Over There” relates that “More than 250,000 Jewish soldiers served in World War I. 3,500 gave their last full measure for their country. 12,000 were wounded and more than 1,100 were decorated for bravery and valor.” Many of those soldiers were from Fort Worth - - Sergeant Benjamin Kaufman in the Battle of the Argonne Forest, Sergeant Philip Katz near Eclisfontaine, Sidney Gumpertz at the Battle of Bois de Forges, and navy Lt. Edouard Izac who escaped German capture and received the Congressional Medal of Honor.”

Dr. Haber returns to the Billy W. Sills Center for the Archives on Saturday, November 10, to offer brief glimpses into the lives and experiences of these extraordinary young men - - some poignant, some tragic, all of them heroic.
