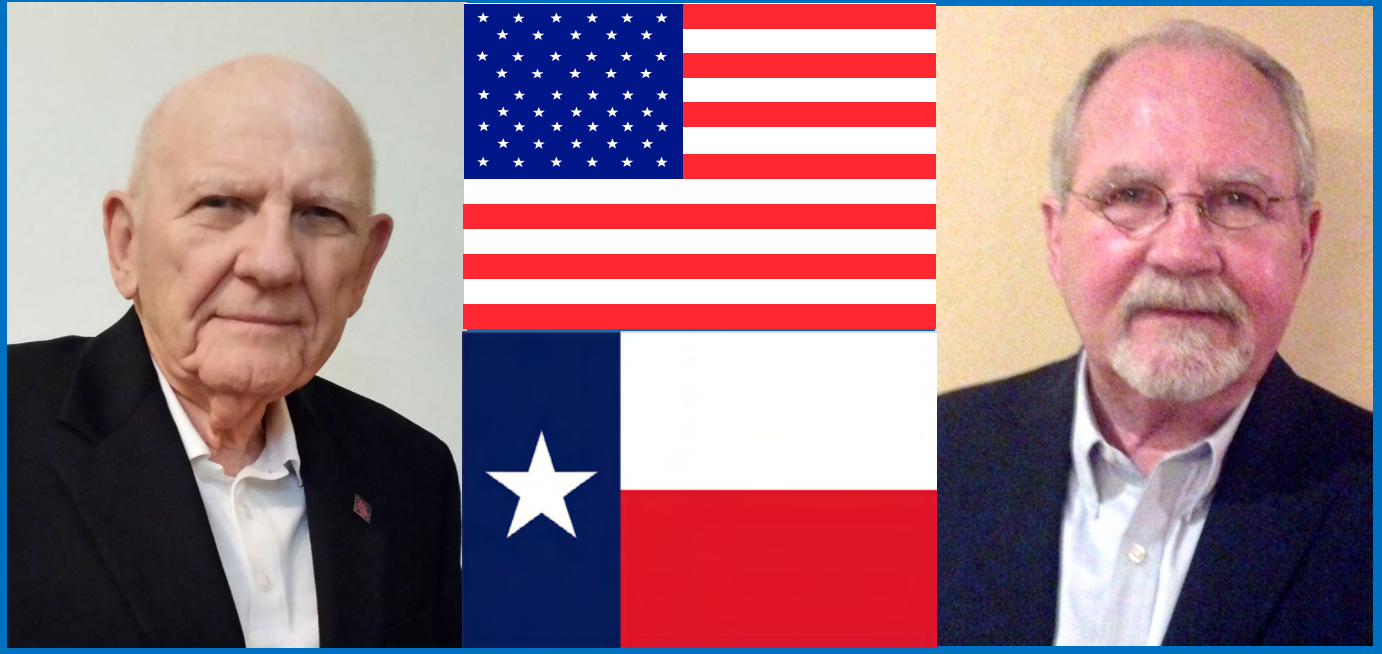


Buckskin Scots and The Littlest Hero:
Authors Loughry and Vanderburg Discuss the
Revolutionary Experience



Join local authors and historians **Art Loughry** and **Dan Vanderburg** as they share their knowledge of the American Revolution and the Texas struggle for independence.

U. S. Marine Col. (ret.) Art Loughry has a large body of published works, including history, genealogy, and military documentary and technical writing for the U.S. government and the Marine Corps. He will read from his new novel, *Buckskin Scots*, based partially on his own family's genealogy, and set in the Revolutionary War period.

Dan Vanderburg is a sixth generation Texan who served in Vietnam on a Navy aircraft flight crew. After a career in the high tech industry moving around the country, he came back to Texas to focus more of his time on writing. He has three historical fiction works, *Legacy of Dreams*, *Trail of Hope*, and *The Littlest Hero*, published in 2012.

Both are members of the North Texas Professional Writers Association and have taught writing workshops at the Arlington Public Library. They will be signing copies of their books following the presentation.
