Born and raised in Fort Worth, Lance Tahmahkera has been with Texas Health Harris Methodist Fort Worth for the past 37 years and is currently, the Imaging Department Manager at TH Harris Methodist Outpatient Center – Burleson. He is a Great-Great Grandson of Comanche Chief, Quanah Parker. With his parents staying close to the Comanche traditions, much of his youth was spent at pow-wows and learning stories about ancestors and tribal ways. The stories vary from the origins of the tribe, life on the plains and reservation, Cynthia Ann and Quanah Parker to current day events.
