In recognition of Hispanic Heritage Month, historian Roberto Calderon will explore the arrival and growth of the Mexican community in North Texas. Dr. Roberto Calderon is Associate Professor of History at the University of North Texas where he specializes in Mexican American History. His previous publications include *Mexican Coal Mining Labor in Texas and Coahuila, 1880- 1930*.
