### “Citing Your Sources”

The importance of properly cited sources in genealogical research cannot be overemphasized. One of the pitfalls of many beginning and some seasoned family historians is failing to document each piece of evidence or clue as it is found and to analyze its validity. Unfortunately, once unsubstantiated files are released in print, by word of mouth, or on the Internet, this faulty information can never be fully retracted. Several excellent books and papers have been written to help writers and researchers understand the concept and mechanics of citing sources.
