“Using DNA in Genealogical Research”

DNA surname projects are fast becoming widespread in the field of family history research. This informative session will help you understand what to expect from DNA testing and how it can support or refute traditional evidence gathered by other methods. You will also learn how you can find and join a surname project.
