March General Meeting

The German-Texan Heritage Society is very active. Elizabeth "Liz" Nitsche Hicks' talk was titled "All I Knowis Great Grandpa Came From Germany". She proceeded to describe many of the ways to put flesh and bones on the bare facts.

It helps a lot if your ancestors left some records. The first place to look is the US Census. However, my ancestor William O. Hughes eluded capture by the census enumerators by all but twice. My ancestor James H. Callaway escaped discovery in 1880 because the enumerator listed his name as James H. Calaway. I finally found him because I knew that he resided in Ellis County, Texas, in 1880. Researchers need to look everywhere for evidence that any given ancestor existed.

Recent messages on the Kilgore mailing list have disclosed that my ancestor, A. Smith Kilgore, is likely the person known as Alexander S. Kilgore. Previously the only direct knowledge of Mr. Kilgore is a listing on a tombstone in Bethlehem Cemetery (in Upshur County, Texas). Mr. Kilgore was the third husband of Mary Jane Buie, and that is the reason for him being on the tombstone.
