Here is a map of the grounds of the Travis Avenue Baptist Church. The Seminar will take place on the second floor of the Children's Ministry Center, as indicated by the yellow label.

Enter the building through the door to which the yellow arrow is pointing. The image on the first page shows this door. There is a stairway and an elevator to transport attendees up to the second floor. Attendees will be expected to identify themselves as such to the guard at the door.

You may park anywhere that is so designated. You gain entrance to the parking lot through entrances on Hemphill Street, Lipscomb Street, or West Berry Street. Both Hemphill and West Berry Streets have four lanes, and it is ill advised to cross the media. Consequently, the safest procedure is to use the Hemphill entrance while traveling south and to use the West Berry entrance while traveling north.

There is an entrance on the west side of the Children's Ministry Center, but it will most likely be locked.
