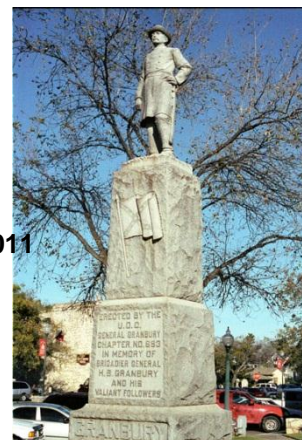

WordPerfect is not necessary for proofreaders. I am sorting the index by page number to make proofreading easy as pie. No constant page flipping.

This final stage of this project is the republishing the marriage records that have been previously published in Footprints. All of that information has already been transcribed and proofread. Indexing and proofreading of the index is all that remains.
